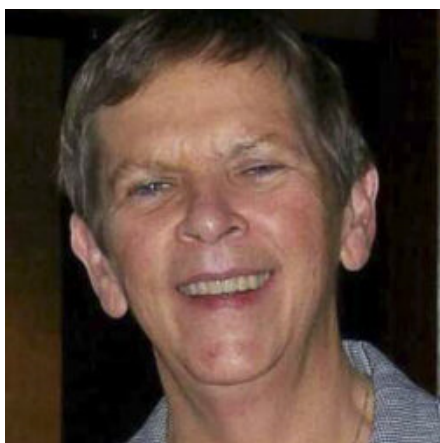


SR. MARGARET MAGEE, OSF ALLEGANY, NY



Sr. Margaret Magee, OSF, is the Congregational Minister for the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany, elected in August 2021 to a four-year term. She served as the Associate Minister for the past nine years and has been a member for 48 years. The Franciscan Sisters of Allegany minister to those in need, especially the underprivileged, the undernourished, the outcast and victims of injustice and violence. They serve the people of God in Jamaica, Brazil, Bolivia, West Indies, Mozambique and the United States. Prior to this, Sr. Margaret served as the Associate Director of the Franciscan Federation, the national organization for Franciscan Third Order Regular congregations of men and women. She has been involved in parish pastoral ministry for 21 years, serving as Director of Religious Education, Director of RCIA and Adult Faith Formation.

Sr. Margaret Magee is the past President and Chair of the Board of the Franciscan Action Network and continues to serve as a member on its Board. She received her bachelor's degree in Theology from St. John's University, a master's degree in Religious Education from LaSalle University and a graduate certificate in Franciscan Studies from Washington Theological Union.
